Question-Answer Relationship

There are three basic types of questions that you will encounter in U.S. History class. Each type of question requires a different level of thinking and work. The types of questions are as follows:

Level I “Right There”

The answers to these questions are explicit in the text. They revolve around the question words who, what, when, and where.

Level II “Think and Search”

The answers to these questions are implicit in the text. They revolve around the questions words of how and why. They require you to read “between the lines” and synthesize information to answer them.

Level III “On My Own”

The answers to these questions are not found in the text. They require application, synthesis, and/or analysis. They are often open-ended questions.
